Fukushima, the Pacific Chernobyl

- Summary of research until 14th of April 2011 -

Introduction: The debate on HAARP and earthquake of 11/3

Here is the latest on the discussion. Rosalie Bertell says in relation to Major Douglas Lind Rokke's assertion that "the depth of the earthquake focal point is too deep so it is very simple - no weapons system can do that."

"Tesla technology of causing vibration of the liquid core of the earth can be caused by humans, and in turn can cause both earthquakes and volcanoes. (But) intent is a difficult thing to prove! Even if we admit to the possibility, that I believe is real, this does not mean that it actually did cause it. The secrecy makes proving this almost impossible!"

1) It is not sure what caused the earthquake/tsunami, beginning on the 9th of March. The enormous magnitude of 9.0 (10./11.th of March) is not easily explained by scientists. There is even a lack of explanation until today.

There are theories about an artificially produced earthquake that range from Haarp activities with Electromagnetic waves via ionospheric heating and consequent "deep-earth-penetrating" beams. Others imagine that the same was done with even "scalar" waves that cannot be measured at all in the three-dimensional space. And a third theory claims that a series of nuclear explosions has been the reason.

2) There is no theory yet about the enormous number of until now more than 1.000 post-earthquake quakes that are all occurring in exactly the same region and amount to more than 7.0 - thus being huge quakes as well.

3) It seems that at least 3 of the 4 nuclear power plant-ruins are in the process of a nuclear meltdown. They could cause or are causing already more and heavy hydrogen-explosions in the surroundings, including the Pacific, that would send or are already sending large amounts of radioactive particles into the higher layers of the atmosphere.

4) The Japanese authorities have now admitted that the catastrophe is as large as the biggest one in history, the Chernobyl disaster of 1986. But in Chernobyl there was only 1 nuclear power plant with about 2,5 tons of fuel rods. In Fukushima each (!) nuclear power plant contains between 40-60 tons of fuel rods, and additionally, Nr. 3 is a Plutonium plant which is the most dangerous of all (Plutonium is used for the bomb and for space rockets, for instance). Plutonium particles have already been found in the surroundings of Fukushima. The Fukushima-disaster will therefore be much, much larger than the one of Chernobyl.

5) The responsible enterprise, TEPCO, is admitting now that it could take months if not years to cool

the ruins. This means that all the radioactivity is permanently going to be distributed not only all over Japan, but all over east Asia, the Northern Pacific and Northamerica and finally the whole world. (Even in Europe it has been measured already).

6) The evacuation zone around Fukushima is much too narrow. It has been widened from 20 to 30 and more km recently. It is admitted that this will be a "dead zone" beyond human use for possibly hundreds of years.

7) The camps for the evacuated do now only accept people who can prove not being contaminated with radioactivity. So, what will happen to those who are contaminated?

🤖 The economic consequences are unimaginable. A bank manager told me already 1 week after the catastrophe: "No building in Tokyo has any value any more." The big business with the World Championship in Athletics in South Korea in sommer 2011 will eventually not be possible any more. The Japanese economy will loose its rank as the 3rd biggest worldwide...Maybe millions of Japanese will try to leave the country...

9) What will pregnant women and mothers of young children in Tokyo and elsewhere do, as babies are 1.000 times more in danger through radioactivity than adult males?

10) Fukushima might be the last warning. A comparable accident could occur in Europe, North America and elsewhere as well. It is even more probable that it will than that it will not. There is no security with this technology that can obvioulsy not be "dominated". It is so dangerous because it takes its energy from destroying the basic principles of matter, and this means of life on earth itself. The violent process of producing this energy can be initiated, but it cannot be stopped any more. There are no fianlly „closed" nucelar plants. They remain a risk, have to release radioactive vapour and water into the environment and have to be cooled furtheron, nearly forever...

11) We have been told that the "earthquake - weapon" has already been used various times to force governments to obey to corporate interests, including Japan in 2010. If this is true we are in the midst of a new world war already which is using weapons of nuclear as well as of non-nuclear mass destruction and the planet as a weapon itself. Such a war could take place everywhere on earth.

12) Trying to explain the power of the nucelar lobby cannot be done without taking into consideration that behind the so called peaceful use of nuclear power - which is never peaceful at all - there is always the military with its hostile use of this power. This is why the nuclear industrial-military complex will try to maintain this technology at all price. The price is our life.

13) The price for a life is now defined: TEPCO pays 3.500 € a day to those who dare to work in the ruins of the nuclear power plants of Fukushima.

14) We are called to become active.
